With so many things to see and do during a safari holiday, you want to be flexible enough to experience it all, and yet remain comfortable while doing so. That's why we offer three different types of safari accommodations — Safari Lodges, Permanent Tented Camps/Lodges, or Mobile Camping. Our experts at Naipenda Safaris can help you customize a trip that includes a combination of one, two or all three of these choices to fit your group's style and budget.

A Safari Lodge is most like a hotel, and many have been designed and built to reflect the indigenous cultures and treasures of Africa.

Permanent Tented lodges or camps are located near the areas where wildlife roam, so you're closer to the action. While each campsite varies in the degree of luxury, you can be assured of a high degree of comfort and service.



The best way to follow the wildlife and get the true safari experience, however, is through Mobile Camping (often called "Hemingway-style"). Again, to fit your group's individual needs, we offer three varieties:



DELUXE MOBILE TENTED camping combines nights in lodges with nights in walk-in sleeping tents. Camps are set up prior to guests' arrival, and consist of luxury sleeping tents with rugs, metal-frame beds and a covered veranda with tables and chairs. The Deluxe camping tents include a separate bath area with shower, flush toilet and pedestal sink. Guests are treated to top-quality linens in their private tents and in the dining tent — are served delicious meals on fine china and crystal.







STANDARD MOBILE TENTED camping employs tents that are similar to the luxury tents – with metal frame beds and private bath facilities en suite – but are slightly more moderate in the amenities provided. Still providing for every comfort and convenience, the standard tents are easier to break down, move and set up again, all of which is done while guests are on a game drive.

BUDGET FLY CAMPING makes use of two-to-four-person pop-up tents that are transported in a separate pull trailer. Our crewmembers set these up for you at public or private campsites so they are ready and waiting at the end of the day. At public campsites, toilet and shower facilities are within easy walking distance, while at private campsites you'll have access to a shower and toilet tent set up specifically for your group.
